

For Such A Time As This Pt3

ESTHER 2:12-14

12. Now when every maid's turn was come to go in to king Ahasuerus, after that she had been twelve months, according to the manner of the women, (for so were the days of their purifications accomplished, to wit, six months with oil of myrrh, and six months with sweet odours, and with other things for the purifying of the women;)

13. Then thus came every maiden unto the king; **whatsoever she desired was given her** to go with her out of the house of the women unto the king's house.

14. In the evening she went, and on the morrow she returned into the second house of the women, to the custody of Shaashgaz, the king's chamberlain, which kept the concubines: **she came in unto the king no more, except the king delighted in her, and that she were called by name.**

CHRIST IS REVEALED IN HIS OWN WORD [65-0822M] See, **that Holy Spirit can fall upon a man, in his spirit.** But his soul is his germ; that germ is the Word. See?

ESTHER 2:13

13. Then thus came every maiden unto the king; **whatsoever she desired was given her** to go with her out of the house of the women unto the king's house.

ESTHER 2:15

15. Now when the turn of Esther, the daughter of Abihail the uncle of Mordecai, who had taken her for his daughter, was come to go in unto the king, **she required nothing but what Hegai** the king's chamberlain, the keeper of the women, **appointed.** And Esther obtained favour in the sight of all them that looked upon her.

THE CONFLICT BETWEEN GOD AND SATAN [62-0531] Like Esther, when Esther was to be chosen to stand before the king, she didn't adorn themselves with all the things, but she adorned herself with a sweet, meek spirit. That's what the Bride is adorning Herself with, with all of the fruits of the Spirit following it.

What She got? Assembling together in the fellowship of the Word. "Amen."
Fellowship of the Word. That's right. Fellowshiping, setting together in Heavenly places in Christ Jesus, tonight: one accord, one place, one Spirit, one mind, one hope, one God, one purpose. "Amen." See? There you are. Every time the Bible says anything, we say, "Amen." Punctuating every Word with, "Amen."

"Fruits of the Spirit." Her, what's She got? What is the fruit of the Spirit? Joy, joy of Her heart, knowing that He's Coming soon. "Amen, and amen, amen." Yeah.

17. And the king loved Esther above all the women, and **she obtained grace and favour in his sight** more than all the virgins; so that he set the royal crown upon her head, and made her queen instead of Vashti.

ESTHER 2:21-23

21. In those days, while Mordecai sat in the king's gate, two of the king's chamberlains, Bigthan and Teresh, of those which kept the door, were wroth, and sought to lay hand on the king Ahasuerus.

22. And the thing was known to Mordecai, who told it unto Esther the queen; and Esther certified the king thereof in Mordecai's name.

23. And when inquisition was made of the matter, it was found out; therefore they were both hanged on a tree: and it was written in the book of the chronicles before the king.
