LUKE 10:33-35

33. But a certain Samaritan, as he journeyed, came where he was: and when he saw him, he had compassion on him,

34. And went to him, and **bound up his wounds, pouring in oil and wine**, and set him on his own beast, and brought him to an inn, and took care of him.

35. And on the morrow when he departed, he took out two pence, and gave them to the host, and said unto him, Take care of him; and whatsoever thou spendest more, when I come again, I will repay thee.

Remember the good Samaritan that found the man wounded? He brought him to the inn (**That's the church.**) and gave the man there **two pence**, and told him if he needed any more he'd pay him when he come. ISAIAH 53:3-7

3. **He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief:** and we hid as it were our faces from him; he was despised, and we esteemed him not.
4. **Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows:** yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted.
5. But **he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities:** the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and **with his stripes we are healed.**
6. All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and **the LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all.**
7. **He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth:** he is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so he openeth not his mouth.

JEREMIAH 30:17

17. For **I will restore health unto thee, and I will heal thee of thy wounds, saith the LORD;** because they called thee an Outcast,

ZECHARIAH 12:10b

10b. ...they shall look upon me whom they have pierced...

ZECHARIAH 13:6

6. And one shall say unto him, **What are these wounds in thine hands?** Then he shall answer, Those with which I was wounded in the house of my friends.

PSALM 121:1-8

1. I will lift up mine eyes unto the hills, from whence cometh my help.
2. **My help cometh from the LORD,** which made heaven and earth.
3. **He will not suffer thy foot to be moved: he that keepeth thee will not slumber.**
4. Behold, he that keepeth Israel shall neither slumber nor sleep.

4. I cried unto the LORD with my voice, and he heard me out of his holy hill. Selah.

7. Arise, O LORD; save me, O my God: for thou hast smitten all mine enemies upon the cheek bone; thou hast broken the teeth of the ungodly.
