

Tongues And Interpretation

I CORINTHIANS 14:26b-28

26b. Let all things be done unto edifying.

27. **If any man speak in an unknown tongue, let it be by two, or at the most by three, and that by course; and let one interpret.**

28. **But if there be no interpreter, let him keep silence in the church; and let him speak to himself, and to God.**

I CORINTHIANS 14:32-34

32. And the spirits of the prophets are subject to the prophets.

33. For God is not the author of confusion, but of peace, as in all churches of the saints.
