

A Scriptural Voice Pt18

HEBREWS 13:20

20. Now the God of peace, that brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant,

THE TOKEN [64-0208]

...the Blood now is an everlasting covenant, the Blood of Jesus Christ.

THE POSITION OF A BELIEVER IN CHRIST [55-0227A]

They don't believe in the supernatural. They're just so far advanced in science, and education, and so forth, that they just--they just explain God all away: the Blood is all gone; the days of miracles is all gone, just explained it away.

ACTS 20:28

28. Take heed therefore unto yourselves, and to all the flock, over the which the Holy Ghost hath made you overseers, to feed the church of God, which he hath purchased with his own blood.

REVELATION 1:5

5. And from Jesus Christ, who is the faithful witness, and the first begotten of the dead, and the prince of the kings of the earth. Unto him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in his own blood,

THE BREACH [63-0317E]

Amen. Raised there today as an Intercessor with His own Blood to make intercession upon the ignorance of the people. Now, oh, that's the One I'm depending on.

GREATER THAN SOLOMON IS HERE [63-0605]

With His Own Blood, as the High Priest, He sets There, over it. How much more ought we to look to the Holy Place of God, where Jesus Himself, our Mediator, the only One between God and man, stands with His Own Blood, to make intercessions on our confession!

CALLING JESUS ON THE SCENE [64-0319]

He's the High Priest of our confession, therefore He cannot do anything for us until first we confess that He has done it. And then when we confess it, then He is the High Priest, a mediator, to go to work on that and make it right.

CALLING JESUS ON THE SCENE [64-0319]

...you've got to first accept what He done for you. See? You've got to accept it, yourself. Then when you accept it, then **He is the High Priest, mediator, to make intercessions upon your confession of what you believe.**

REVELATION 5:2-5

2. And I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice, Who is worthy to open the book, and to loose the seals thereof?
3. And no man in heaven, nor in earth, neither under the earth, was able to open the book, neither to look thereon.
4. And I wept much, because no man was found worthy to open and to read the book, neither to look thereon.
5. And one of the elders saith unto me, Weep not: behold, the Lion of the tribe of Juda, the Root of David, hath prevailed to open the book, and to loose the seven seals thereof.

CONFERENCES [63-0608]

He is in the work now, doing the work of redemption. But someday He walks from the sanctuary, to take up the Book of redemption that He's purchased with His Own Blood, then the hour is over.

THE FIRST SEAL [63-0318]

...**Christ has to stay on the mediatorial seat back there as an Intercessor until that last one comes in at the last age.**

THE THIRD SEAL [63-0320]

He had been back there in His--**doing His mediatorial work,** for He was bleeding for the people, **interceding for the people until the last soul that was put on the Lamb's Book of Life before the foundation of the world come in.** There's just going to be so many of them there, and that's it. That's all. The others won't even want to come in; they have no desire to come in. And so then when that last soul comes in, then the time of redemption is finished.

THE FOURTH SEAL [63-0321]

Them names were put on the Lamb's Book of Life before the foundation of the world, will come forth just as certain as anything. That's why **Jesus sets right there and waits with His mediatorial work until that last seed.**

Q&A ON THE SEALS [63-0324M]

When the Lamb leaves that seat of the throne, to--being a Mediator, **He becomes down here, and the day of redemption for the church is finished.**

The Lamb is the only Mediator.

CHURCH AGE BOOK - page 221

...there is no other mediator save the Son.

THE BREACH [63-0317E]

Come while **the Mediator, as far as I know, is still on the throne making intercessions,** because there will come a day when you'll want to come, and there will be no Mediator.

THE FOURTH SEAL [63-0321]

...Christ was at the throne as a Mediator, **the only Mediator.** Therefore, there could be no saint, no Mary, no Joseph, no nothing else on that altar, because it was Blood, and **only the Blood of Jesus could make the atonement. So nothing else could be standing as a mediator.** That's right. There was nothing else.

HEBREWS 9:22b

22b. ...and **without shedding of blood is no remission.**

THE SIXTH SEAL [63-0323]

Then **how dare anybody to say that Mary, or Joseph, or any other mortal could be--be an intercessor. You cannot intercess unless there's Blood there.** Yes sir, there's one Mediator between God and man, and that's Christ Jesus. That's what the Scriptures says. There He stands, and **until the last soul has been redeemed,** and then He comes forth to claim what He has redeemed...

CHURCH AGE BOOK - page 93

That false vine was getting a hold and it was teaching that rulership by man was right. It taught that the church had to be governed. It taught a control over the people, but instead of doing it God's way, they simply took authority and vested all the spiritual power in their own hands and came out with a holy priesthood standing between God and the people. They went right back to the old Aaronic system. **They became antichrist for they disposed of His mediator-ship and imposed their own. God hated that.** The Ephesians hated that **and any true believer will hate it too.**

We would have to be stone blind not to see that same thing at work all through the ages and right now it is the worst of all. What it was, was organization. That separated the people. God's people are supposed to be one. By ONE Spirit are they ALL baptized into one body and EVERYONE is to be moved upon by the Holy Ghost and EVERYONE is to participate in the worship of God. **But men wanted the preeminence,** so they took over control, and bishops became archbishops, and with imposing titles they by-passed the Word of God and taught their own doctrines. They got the people to obey them until the time came that **their way of worship did not in any way at all resemble the early days after Pentecost.**

SOULS THAT ARE IN PRISON NOW [63-1110M]

It was the Book of Redemption. And everything that He had redeemed was written in that Book. All that He died for was written in the Book, and **He could not leave His mediatorial Seat until He had thoroughly redeemed. And He couldn't redeem it at the cross,** because they were predestinated in the Lamb's Book of Life, and **He had to stay on There to make intercessions until that last person was finished.** Glory!

CHRIST IS IDENTIFIED THE SAME IN ALL GENERATIONS [64-0415]

He is setting at the right hand of God, tonight, doing His mediatorial work. And when that last soul is saved, that was redeemed, and seen and knowed by God before the foundation of the world; **when that last soul is saved, that closes the Book.**
