Pray Like Jesus

JOHN 13:15 For I have given you an example, that ye should do as I have done to you.

MARK 1:35

35. And in the morning, rising up a great while before day, he went out, and departed into a solitary place, and there prayed.

LUKE 5:16 And he withdrew himself into the wilderness, and prayed.

LUKE 6:12

12. And it came to pass in those days, that he went out into a mountain to pray, and continued all night in prayer to God.

SHOW US THE FATHER [63-0606]

A woman said, "**Who did He pray to, in the garden of Gethsemane,**" on a street meeting one time.

I said, "I want to ask you something. You testified you had **the Holy Ghost**. Where is It at? **What do you pray to?**" **It's on the inside of you,** of course.

Well, we have the Spirit with measure. He had It without measure.

MATTHEW 14:23

23. And when he had sent the multitudes away, he went up into a mountain apart to pray: and when the evening was come, he was there alone.

MATTHEW 17:21 Howbeit this kind goeth not out but by prayer and fasting.

MATTHEW 6:5-15

5. And when thou prayest, thou shalt not be as the hypocrites are: for they love to pray standing in the synagogues and in the corners of the streets, that they may be seen of men. Verily I say unto you, They have their reward.

6. But thou, when thou prayest, enter into thy closet, and when thou hast shut thy door, pray to thy Father which is in secret; and thy Father which seeth in secret shall reward thee openly.

7. But when ye pray, use not vain repetitions, as the heathen do: for they think that they shall be heard for their much speaking.

8. Be not ye therefore like unto them: for **your Father knoweth what things ye have need of, before ye ask him.**
9. After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name.
10. Thy kingdom come. **Thy will be done** in earth, as it is in heaven.
11. Give us this day our daily bread.
12. And forgive us our debts, **as we forgive our debtors.**
13. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever. Amen.
14. For if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you:
15. But if ye forgive not men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.

MARK 11:25-26

25. And **when ye stand praying, forgive**, if ye have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses.
26. But if ye do not forgive, neither will your Father which is in heaven forgive your trespasses.

MATTHEW 5:44

44. But I say unto you, Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and **pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you;**

LUKE 22:31-34

31. And the Lord said, Simon, Simon, behold, Satan hath desired to have you, that he may sift you as wheat:
32. **But I have prayed for thee, that thy faith fail not:** and when thou art converted, strengthen thy brethren.
33. And he said unto him, Lord, I am ready to go with thee, both into prison, and to death.
34. And he said, I tell thee, Peter, the cock shall not crow this day, before that thou shalt thrice deny that thou knowest me.

JOHN 17:15-21

15. I pray not that thou shouldest take them out of the world, but that thou shouldest keep them from the evil.
16. They are not of the world, even as I am not of the world.
17. Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth.
18. As thou hast sent me into the world, even so have I also sent them into the world.

19. And for their sakes I sanctify myself, that they also might be sanctified through the truth.

20. Neither pray I for these alone, but for them also which shall believe on me through their word;

21. That they all may be one; as thou, Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe that thou hast sent me.

MARK 13:33 Take ye heed, watch and pray: for ye know not when the time is.

MATTHEW 26:39-44

39. And he went a little further, and fell on his face, and prayed, saying, O my Father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from me: nevertheless not as I will, but as thou wilt.

40. And he cometh unto the disciples, and findeth them asleep, and saith unto Peter, What, could ye not watch with me one hour?

41. Watch and pray, that ye enter not into temptation: the spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak.

42. He went away again the second time, and prayed, saying, O my Father, if this cup may not pass away from me, except I drink it, thy will be done.

43. And he came and found them asleep again: for their eyes were heavy.

44. And he left them, and went away again, and prayed the third time, saying the same words.

JOHN 14:19

19. Yet a little while, and the world seeth me no more; but ye see me: because I live, ye shall live also.

JOHN 14:3

3. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also.

JOHN 15:20

20. Remember the word that I said unto you, The servant is not greater than his lord. If they have persecuted me, they will also persecute you; if they have kept my saying, they will keep yours also.

JOHN 14:12-14

12. Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father.

13. And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. 14. **If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it.**

JOHN 15:16

16. Ye have not chosen me, but I have chosen you, and ordained you, that ye should go and bring forth fruit, and that your fruit should remain: that **whatsoever ye shall ask of the Father in my name, he may give it you.**

JOHN 16:24

24. Hitherto have ye asked nothing in my name: **ask, and ye shall receive, that your joy may be full.**

MARK 11:22-26

22. And Jesus answering saith unto them, **Have faith in God.**

23. For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; **he shall have whatsoever he saith.**

24. Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, **when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.**

MATTHEW 21:22

22. And all things, **whatsoever ye shall ask in prayer, believing, ye shall receive.**

Jesus said, "*Whatever you ask the Father in My Name, that will I do.*" Did you ever realize what that means? Do you realize **if we go before God in the Name of Jesus, it's just the same as Jesus Himself praying?** It isn't me praying any more.
