MARK 8:31-33

31. *And he began to teach them, that the Son of man must suffer many things, and be rejected of the elders, and of the chief priests, and scribes, and be killed, and after three days rise again.*
32. *And he spake that saying openly. And Peter took him, and began to rebuke him.*
33. *But when he had turned about and looked on his disciples, he rebuked Peter, saying, Get thee behind me, Satan: for thou savourest not the things that be of God, but the things that be of men.*

JOHN 9:6-7

7. *And said unto him, Go, wash in the pool of Siloam, (which is by interpretation, Sent.) He went his way therefore, and washed, and came seeing.*

JOHN 9:18

18. *But the Jews did not believe concerning him, that he had been blind, and received his sight, until they called the parents of him that had received his sight.*

JOHN 9:24-34

24. *Then again called they the man that was blind, and said unto him, Give God the praise: we know that this man is a sinner.*
25. *He answered and said, Whether he be a sinner or no, I know not: one thing I know, that, whereas I was blind, now I see.*
26. *Then said they to him again, What did he to thee? how opened he thine eyes?*
27. *He answered them, I have told you already, and ye did not hear: wherefore would ye hear it again? will ye also be his disciples?*
28. *Then they reviled him, and said, Thou art his disciple; but we are Moses' disciples.*

29. *We know that God spake unto Moses: as for this fellow, we know not from whence he is.*
30. *The man answered and said unto them, Why herein is a marvellous thing, that ye know not from whence he is, and yet he hath opened mine eyes.*
31. *Now we know that God heareth not sinners: but if any man be a worshipper of God, and doeth his will, him he heareth.*
32. *Since the world began was it not heard that any man opened the eyes of one that was born blind.*
33. *If this man were not of God, he could do nothing.* 34. *They answered and said unto him, Thou wast altogether born in sins, and dost thou teach us? And they cast him out.*

MATTHEW 23:13

13. *But woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for **ye shut up the kingdom of heaven against men:** for ye neither go in yourselves, **neither suffer ye them that are entering to go in.***
