Usually it takes experience. Many times we try to educate ourself into believing. That's intellectual. There is a far great difference between **intellectual faith** and **real God sent faith.**

That **intellectual faith** will get you nowhere. Might get you emotional, but it won't get you the healing that you're looking for.

Your emotions will never build... it'll build a material, **intellectual faith**, but it'll never build a faith in your heart. Let the Word sink down. Just believe God. If thou canst believe, all things are possible.
