THE IDENTIFIED CHRIST OF ALL AGES [64-0401]

Reminds me of a fellow, one time, had some ducks, and he--he cut their wings so they couldn't fly out of a pen. He had some ducks on one side, and ducks on the other. Water begin to come in. The first thing you know, the water got higher and higher, and ducks got together then. See? **That's what we need to do.** Let the waters go to rising, and then the ducks get together, you see, then. And we're all in the same water. So, denominational barriers can be floated out, if we'll **just let the waters get deep enough.**

Like a man had a cornfield. A fellow kept saying... He had one field, plants off this way; another one this way. And so a fellow flying over, every morning, would look at that cornfield. He said, "Isn't that a fine cornfield here, and one there!" After the corn got a little higher, reached all the way across the fence, it looked like one field. Christ, the Chief Captain of our salvation, there He stands, the great conqueror. He rent the veil in two, and **took down all the middle walls of partition, invited "whosoever will"** to come and partake of His Life, be covered with His Divine blessings...

THE CHURCH AND ITS CONDITION [56-0805]

And the only thing the devil wants you to do, is just turn aside just for a few minutes. He can paint the picture, say, "Now, look here. You know, brother, you know, sister, if they were the right kind of people, they wouldn't do this. If they just did this right here, you know." **He can make it so real to you until it becomes a real truth.** That's right. **But remember, it's the devil.**

I don't care how lowdown they are, how far they've stooped in sin; it's your business to put an arm around them and lift them up by the love of God. Where was you when the Dove of God lifted you out of the miry clay? It's your business, my friend. This world is dying for a little bit of love.

DIVINE LOVE [56-0826] Many people pray for sinners. That's all right, but that's not the way to win a sinner. It's your business to win the sinner. **You don't win him by praying for him. You win-win--win him by talking to him and introducing to him Christ.** That's your business. That's your duty is to win sinners by talking to them, and projecting to them the love of God through the Word of God that wins the sinner.

CONFERENCES [60-0228]

The need of the church tonight is a conference, a prayer meeting, a get together, call together.

Ministers, break down their middle wall of partition. Church members that'll forget the differences between the denominations of churches. Church members, and ministers, hold to the horns of the altar with one accord and pray until the fire of God begins to fall again. God knows the... The stubbornness, indifference of men is broke up, and godly fear, and brotherly love takes its place in the human heart. **Then you'll become salty. Then the message will have its preeminences in the heart. It'll have its influence in the city.**

We could scream, and shout, and do whatever we want to; it'll never influence man until they see the life of Christ being projected in you, someone who's tender, and merciful, and forgiving, and ready to--to turn the other side of the cheek, or give the second coat, or go the second mile: **Christianity in action, not just taught from the pulpit, but acted among the members, among the pastors.** That's when you see Christ living in the church, decisions made.
