Love Is Corrective Pt1

JOB 5:17

17. Behold, happy is the man whom God correcteth: therefore despise not thou the chastening of the Almighty:

THE BAPTISM OF THE HOLY SPIRIT [58-0928M]

If I make this real strong, I'm not meaning it now to you--to you dear people. The only thing I'm trying to do is drive it in, and we're going to make it rough. You see? So you got to speak like... You say, "Johnny, go sit down." He might not listen to that, but you say, [Brother Branham shouts the following--Ed.] "Johnny, sit down!" Johnny will pay more attention to it. So now, we're going to holler, "Johnny sit down!" this morning. See? All right. I want to speak it so that you'll understand what we're meaning. See?

PROVERBS 3:11-12

- 11. My son, despise not the chastening of the LORD; neither be weary of his correction:
- 12. For <u>whom the LORD loveth he correcteth</u>; even as a father the son in whom he delighteth.

THE SECOND SEAL [63-0319] Love is corrective. If it isn't corrective, it isn't love.

ONCE MORE [63-0804A] Love is corrective. If love doesn't correct, then it's not love.

THE UNCERTAIN SOUND [62-0714]

That's the reason sometimes people think I--I--I get rough with people, bawling them out. It's not 'cause I don't love you, it's because I do love you. What if your little boy was setting out in the street, and you said, "Junior, dear, I--I... You shouldn't set out there. Daddy don't want to hurt..." You'd better strip the hide off of him, if you love him. Keep him in off of that street. **Real love is corrective. Genuine love is corrective.**

What if your wife was running around with some other man, and you said, "Dear, I--I hope you have a good time, but really I don't think you should do it." She ought to kick you out the door. That's right. Yeah. **Real love is corrective**. That's right.

PROVERBS 22:15

15. Foolishness is bound in the heart of a child; but the rod of correction shall drive it far from him.

PERSEVERANT [62-0729]

If you had your little baby setting out here on the street, and you know the traffic swinging by there, would you say, "Junior, dear, I think you should come in." That's just about the way some ministers try to correct their congregation. Why, if you was a real mother or dad, you'd go out there and get him in out of there. And if he went out again, you'd have you a stick the next time in your hand when you went after him. That don't show you don't like the child. It shows you love the child, you know.

THE WORLD IS FALLING APART [63-0412M]

And that's what's the matter with our ministry today. They're there. It's a meal ticket. It's a denominational affair, and <u>they're afraid to handle the Gospel the way It should</u> be handled.

HEBREWS 12:5-9

- 6. For whom the Lord loveth he [chasteneth], and scourgeth every son whom he receiveth.

FELLOWSHIP WITH GOD THROUGH RECONCILIATION [56-0120]

You can't educate people to love one another. You think you can, but <u>it takes a Divine</u> <u>order to do that</u>. There's no way to do it through education.
