## I CORINTHIANS 10:6-7

6. *Now these things were our examples, to the intent we should not lust after evil things, as they also lusted.* 7. **Neither be ye idolaters**, as were some of them; as it is written, *The people sat down to eat and drink, and rose up to play.*

## CORINTHIANS BOOK OF CORRECTION [57-0414]

BE CERTAIN OF GOD [59-0708E] We had more man like Jehu today, we'd have less Jezebels. But that was her nature, and she was a worshiper of idolatry. And she brought the whole nation to idolatry. And so has our modern trend today, falling away from the things of God and has brought the world to **one of the greatest idolatries that we have, that's idleness. Just idling around.**

## I TIMOTHY 5:13

13. *And withal they learn to be idle, wandering about from house to house; and not only idle, but tattlers also and busybodies, speaking things which they ought not.*

## PROVERBS 6:6-11

6. *Go to the ant, thou sluggard; consider her ways, and be wise: 7. Which having no guide, overseer, or ruler, 8. Provideth her meat in the summer, and gathereth her food in the harvest. 9. How long wilt thou sleep, O sluggard? when wilt thou arise out of thy sleep? 10. Yet a little sleep, a little slumber, a little folding of the hands to sleep: 11. So shall thy poverty come as one that travelleth, and thy want as an armed man.*

## PROVERBS 19:15

15. *Slothfulness casteth into a deep sleep; and an idle soul shall suffer hunger.*

## I TIMOTHY 5:8

8. *But if any provide not for his own, and specially for those of his own house, he hath denied the faith, and is **worse than an infidel.***
