The Attributes Of Love Pt23

The Fulfilling Of The Law

ROMANS 13:8-10

8. Owe no man any thing, but to love one another: for he that loveth another hath fulfilled the *law*.

9. For this, Thou shalt not commit adultery, Thou shalt not kill, Thou shalt not steal, Thou shalt not bear false witness, Thou shalt not covet; and if there be any other commandment, it is briefly comprehended in this saying, namely, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.
10. Love worketh no ill to his neighbour: therefore love is the fulfilling of the law.

MATTHEW 22:37-40

37. Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind.

- *38. This is the first and great commandment.*
- 39. And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.

40. <u>On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets</u>.

GALATIANS 6:1

1. Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are spiritual, restore such an one in the spirit of meekness; considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted.

2. Bear ye one another's burdens, and so fulfil the law of Christ.

3. For if a man think himself to be something, when he is nothing, he deceiveth himself.

II CORINTHIANS 3:5-6

5. Not that we are sufficient of ourselves to think any thing as of ourselves; but our sufficiency *is of God;*

6. Who also hath made us able ministers of the new testament; not of the letter, but of the spirit: *for the letter killeth, but the spirit giveth life*.
