The Attribute Of Father Pt2

LUKE 15:25-32

- 25. Now his elder son was in the field: and as he came and drew nigh to the house, he heard musick and dancing.
- 26. And he called one of the servants, and asked what these things meant.
- 227. And he said unto him, Thy brother is come; and thy father hath killed the fatted calf, because he hath received him safe and sound.
- 28. And he was angry, and would not go in: therefore came his father out, and intreated him.
- 29. And he answering said to his father, Lo, these many years do I serve thee, neither transgressed I at any time thy commandment: and yet thou never gavest me a kid, that I might make merry with my friends:
- 30. But as soon as this thy son was come, which hath devoured thy living with harlots, thou hast killed for him the fatted calf.
- 31. And he said unto him, Son, thou art ever with me, and all that I have is thine.
- 32. It was meet that we should make merry, and be glad: for this thy brother was dead, and is alive again; and was lost, and is found.

LUKE 15:1-3

- 1. Then drew near unto him all the publicans and sinners for to hear him.
- 2. And the Pharisees and scribes murmured, saying, This man receiveth sinners, and eateth with them.
- 3. And he spake this parable unto them, saying,

MATTHEW 18:12-14

- 12. How think ye? if a man have an hundred sheep, and one of them be gone astray, doth he not leave the ninety and nine, and goeth into the mountains, and seeketh that which is gone astray?
- 13. And if so be that he find it, verily I say unto you, he rejoiceth more of that sheep, than of the ninety and nine which went not astray.
- 14. Even so it is not the will of your Father which is in heaven, that one of these little ones should perish.

LUKE 15:6-7

- 6. And when he cometh home, he calleth together his friends and neighbours, saying unto them, Rejoice with me; for I have found my sheep which was lost.
- 7. I say unto you, that likewise joy shall be in heaven over one sinner that repenteth, more than over ninety and nine just persons, which need no repentance.

MATTHEW 9:10-13

- 10. And it came to pass, as Jesus sat at meat in the house, behold, many publicans and sinners came and sat down with him and his disciples.
- 11. And when the Pharisees saw it, they said unto his disciples, Why eateth your Master with publicans and sinners?
- 12. But when Jesus heard that, he said unto them, They that be whole need not a physician, but they that are sick.
- 13. But go ye and learn what that meaneth, I will have mercy, and not sacrifice: for I am not come to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance.

MATTHEW 18:1-7

- 1. At the same time came the disciples unto Jesus, saying, Who is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven?
- 2. And Jesus called a little child unto him, and set him in the midst of them,
- 3. And said, Verily I say unto you, Except ye be converted, and become as little children, ye shall not enter into the kingdom of heaven.
- 4. Whosoever therefore shall humble himself as this little child, the same is greatest in the kingdom of heaven.
- 5. And whoso shall receive one such little child in my name receiveth me.
- 6. But whoso shall offend one of these little ones which believe in me, it were better for him that a millstone were hanged about his neck, and that he were drowned in the depth of the sea.
- 7. Woe unto the world because of offences! for it must needs be that offences come; but woe to that man by whom the offence cometh!

MATTHEW 25:40

40. And the King shall answer and say unto them, Verily I say unto you, Inasmuch as ye have done it unto one of the least of these my brethren, ye have done it unto me.

MATTHEW 25:45

45. Then shall he answer them, saying, Verily I say unto you, Inasmuch as ye did it not to one of the least of these, ye did it not to me.
