Where Doctrine Comes From Pt2

MATTHEW 7:28-29

28. *And it came to pass, when Jesus had ended these sayings, the people were astonished at his [doctrine]:*

29. *For he taught them as one having authority, and not as the scribes.*

GREEK LEXICON - STRONG'S NUMBER 1322

didache {did-akh-ay'}

1) *teaching, i.e. that which is taught; doctrine, teaching, concerning something*

2) *the act of teaching, instruction; in religious assemblies of the Christians, to speak in the way of teaching, in distinction from other modes of speaking in public*

MARK 7:6-9

6. *He answered and said unto them, Well hath Esaias prophesied of you hypocrites, as it is written, This people honoureth me with their lips, but their heart is far from me.*

7. *Howbeit in vain do they worship me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men.*

8. *For laying aside the commandment of God, ye hold the tradition of men, as the washing of pots and cups: and many other such like things ye do.*

9. *And he said unto them, Full well ye reject the commandment of God, that ye may keep your own tradition.*

PRESUMING [62-0408]

If you'd draw up your creeds, your plans, your doctrines, your Bible doctrines, and then end it with a comma, "We believe this, plus as much as God will let us have, show us," that's all right. But you draw it up with a period, "We believe this, and nothing else." And then it shuts God right out when you make a period.

MATTHEW 16:6-12

6. *Then Jesus said unto them, Take heed and beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and of the Sadducees.*

7. *And they reasoned among themselves, saying, It is because we have taken no bread.*

8. *Which when Jesus perceived, he said unto them, O ye of little faith, why reason ye among yourselves, because ye have brought no bread?*

9. *Do ye not yet understand, neither remember the five loaves of the five thousand, and how many baskets ye took up?*

10. *Neither the seven loaves of the four thousand, and how many baskets ye took up?*

11. *How is it that ye do not understand that I spake it not to you concerning bread, that ye should beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and of the Sadducees?*

12. *Then understood they how that he bade them not beware of the leaven of bread, but of the doctrine of the Pharisees and of the Sadducees.*

THE MESSAGE OF GRACE [61-0827]

So you see, God wants somebody that'll obey Him. **If it's not in the Scriptures, then it's not of man--it's a man-made doctrine and not a Bible doctrine.** See? So regardless of what the church is, how wrong you've been, what difference does that make? **It's how right you can be now. God's grace has showed it to you, then walk in it.**

JOHN 7:16-17

16. *Jesus answered them, and said, My doctrine is not mine, but his that sent me.*

17. *If any man will do his will, he shall know of the doctrine, whether it be of God, or whether I speak of myself.*

EPHESIANS 4:14

14. *That we henceforth be no more children, tossed to and fro, and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the sleight of men, and cunning craftiness, whereby they lie in wait to deceive;*

HE SWORE BY HIMSELF [54-1212]

Not weaved about with every doctrine and every wind, tossed about from one side to another, taking sides over here, and taking sides over here, **don't know where you stand.** The Bible said, "*I would that you'd be established.*" Not saying, "Well, I'm a--I'm this today and something else tomorrow." **Anchor your soul in Christ Jesus.**

HEBREWS 13:9

9. *Be not carried about with divers and strange doctrines. For it is a good thing that the heart be [established] with grace; not with meats, which have not profited them that have been occupied therein.*

1) to make firm, establish, confirm, make sure

LUKE 22:32

32. *But I have prayed for thee, that thy faith fail not: and when thou art converted, [strengthen] thy brethren.*

GREEK LEXICON - STRONG'S NUMBER 4741

sterizo {stay-rid'-zo}

- 1a) to make stable, place firmly, set fast, fix: to set one's face steadfastly, keep the face turned
1b) to strengthen, make firm; to render constant, confirm, one's mind

II PETER 1:12-13

12. Wherefore I will not be negligent to put you always in remembrance of these things, though ye know them, and **be [established] in the present truth.**
13. Yea, I think it meet, as long as I am in this tabernacle, to stir you up by putting you in remembrance;

I THESSALONIANS 3:2

2. And sent Timotheus, our brother, and minister of God, and our fellowlabourer in the gospel of Christ, **to [establish] you, and to comfort you concerning your faith:**

II THESSALONIANS 3:3

3. But the Lord is faithful, who shall [stablish] you, and keep you from evil.

- 2a. Be watchful, and [strengthen] the things which remain,

GOD KEEPS HIS WORD PT1 [57-0306]

...doctrine can't be based upon some experience. **Doctrine is based on God's Word**, not on experience. People can have experiences of everything.

JESUS CHRIST THE SAME YESTERDAY TODAY AND FOREVER [54-0824] [Emmaus]

Once they got Jesus on the inside with them, He made Himself known to them. You get what I mean? Now, if you'll just let Jesus... **Just get off all your doctrines and things and take what it's the Bible said Jesus was**, and let Him... Just lock Him up in your house tonight, with you, and He will make himself known to you.
