JUDGES 15:16-19

16. *And Samson said, With the jawbone of an ass, heaps upon heaps, with the jaw of an ass have I slain a thousand men.*
17. *And it came to pass, when he had made an end of speaking, that he cast away the jawbone out of his hand, and called that place [Ramathlehi].*
18. *And **he was sore athirst**, and called on the LORD, and said, Thou hast given this great deliverance into the hand of thy servant: and now shall I die for thirst, and fall into the hand of the uncircumcised?*
19. ***But God clave an hollow place that was in the jaw, and there came water thereout: and when he had drunk, his spirit came again, and he revived: wherefore he called the name thereof [Enhakkore], which is in Lehi unto this day.***

THIRST [65-0919]

I used to see a little sign, said, "If you're thirsty, say Parfay." There used to be a little drink, when I was a boy, called Parfay. I remember coming down the road, oh, from fishing, I had been up to the pond, old stagnant waters. And I was about starved to death, and I seen a sign say, "If you're thirsty, just say Parfay." And I started saying, "Parfay, Parfay." I got thirstier all the time. And I--I... See, I--I--I got so I couldn't even spit, after a while, I was so--so thirsty.

Well, you see, that won't do it. There is nothing will satisfy it. I don't care, you can drink cokes, you can drink anything you want to, with them sweetened by carbonated waters, and so forth, there is nothing that will satisfy the thirst like a good cool, cold stream of water. That'll quench that thirst. **All these other things are substitutes.**
