

Spiritual Manna

PSALM 78:18-25

18. *And they tempted God in their heart by asking meat for their lust.*
19. *Yea, they spake against God; they said, Can God furnish a table in the wilderness?*
20. *Behold, he smote the rock, that the waters gushed out, and the streams overflowed; can he give bread also? can he provide flesh for his people?*
21. *Therefore the LORD heard this, and was wroth: so a fire was kindled against Jacob, and anger also came up against Israel;*
22. *Because they believed not in God, and trusted not in his salvation:*
23. *Though he had commanded the clouds from above, and opened the doors of heaven,*
24. *And had rained down manna upon them to eat, and had given them of the corn of heaven.*
25. *Man did eat angels' food: he sent them meat to the full.*

JOHN 6:30-31

30. *They said therefore unto him, What sign shewest thou then, that we may see, and believe thee? what dost thou work?*
31. *Our fathers did eat manna in the desert; as it is written, He gave them bread from heaven to eat.*

JOHN 6:49

49. *Your fathers did eat manna in the wilderness, and are dead.*

CHURCH AGE BOOK

Those parents that died were necessary as the forefathers of the people to whom Jesus was speaking. They perished, yet they were in the election of God naturally as Joshua and Caleb were Spiritually.

JOSHUA 1:1-3

1. *Now after the death of Moses the servant of the LORD it came to pass, that the LORD spake unto Joshua the son of Nun, Moses' minister, saying,*
2. *Moses my servant is dead; now therefore arise, go over this Jordan, thou, and all this people, unto the land which I do give to them, even to the children of Israel.*
3. *Every place that the sole of your foot shall tread upon, that have I given unto you, as I said unto Moses.*

JOSHUA 1:7-8

7. *Only be thou strong and very courageous, that thou mayest observe to do according to all the law, which Moses my servant commanded thee: turn not from it to the right hand or to the left, that thou mayest prosper whithersoever thou goest.*

8. *This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success.*

JOSHUA 8:30-32

30. *Then Joshua built an altar unto the LORD God of Israel in mount Ebal,*

31. *As Moses the servant of the LORD commanded the children of Israel, as it is written in the book of the law of Moses, an altar of whole stones, over which no man hath lift up any iron: and they offered thereon burnt offerings unto the LORD, and sacrificed peace offerings.*

32. *And he wrote there upon the stones a copy of the law of Moses, which he wrote in the presence of the children of Israel.*

JOSHUA 8:34-35

34. *And afterward he read all the words of the law, the blessings and cursings, according to all that is written in the book of the law.*

35. *There was not a word of all that Moses commanded, which Joshua read not before all the congregation of Israel, with the women, and the little ones, and the strangers that were conversant among them.*

JOSHUA 11:15

15. *As the LORD commanded Moses his servant, so did Moses command Joshua, and so did Joshua; he left nothing undone of all that the LORD commanded Moses.*

JOSHUA 22:5a

5a. *But take diligent heed to do the commandment and the law, which Moses the servant of the LORD charged you,*

JOSHUA 23:6

6. *Be ye therefore very courageous to keep and to do all that is written in the book of the law of Moses, that ye turn not aside therefrom to the right hand or to the left;*

JOSHUA 24:31

31. *And Israel served the LORD all the days of Joshua, and all the days of the elders that overlived Joshua, and which had known all the works of the LORD, that he had done for Israel.*

JUDGES 2:7

7. *And the people served the LORD all the days of Joshua, and all the days of the elders that outlived Joshua, who had seen all the great works of the LORD, that he did for Israel.*

JUDGES 2:10-13

10. *And also all that generation were gathered unto their fathers: and there arose another generation after them, which knew not the LORD, nor yet the works which he had done for Israel.*

11. *And the children of Israel did evil in the sight of the LORD, and served Baalim:*

12. *And they forsook the LORD God of their fathers, which brought them out of the land of Egypt, and followed other gods, of the gods of the people that were round about them, and bowed themselves unto them, and provoked the LORD to anger.*

13. *And they forsook the LORD, and served Baal and Ashtaroth.*

JUDGES 3:4

4. *And they were to prove Israel by them, to know whether they would hearken unto the commandments of the LORD, which he commanded their fathers by the hand of Moses.*

REVELATION 10:7

7. *But in the days of the voice of the seventh angel, when he shall begin to sound, the mystery of God should be finished, as he hath declared to his servants the prophets.*

MATTHEW 24:45-46

45. *Who then is a faithful and wise servant, whom his lord hath made ruler over his household, to give them meat in due season?*

46. *Blessed is that servant, whom his lord when he cometh shall find so doing.*
