ACTS 14:7-15

- 7. And there they preached the gospel.
- 8. And there sat a certain man at Lystra, impotent in his feet, being a cripple from his mother's womb, who never had walked:
- 9. The same heard Paul speak: who stedfastly beholding him, and perceiving that he had faith to be healed,
- 10. Said with a loud voice, Stand upright on thy feet. And he leaped and walked.
