I CORINTHIANS 12:4-6

- 4. Now there are diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit.
- 5. And there are differences of [administrations], but the same Lord.
- 6. And there are diversities of operations, but it is the same God which worketh all in all.

ACTS 6:1-4

- 1. And in those days, when the number of the disciples was multiplied, there arose a murmuring of the Grecians against the Hebrews, because their widows were neglected in the daily [ministration].
- 2. Then the twelve called the multitude of the disciples unto them, and said, It is not reason that we should leave the word of God, and serve tables.
- 3. Wherefore, brethren, look ye out among you seven men of honest report, full of the Holy Ghost and wisdom, whom we may appoint over this business.
- 4. But we will give ourselves continually to prayer, and to the [ministry] of the word.

ACTS 11:28-30

- 28. And there stood up one of them named Agabus, and signified by the Spirit that there should be great dearth throughout all the world: which came to pass in the days of Claudius Caesar.
- 29. Then the disciples, every man according to his ability, determined to send [relief] unto the brethren which dwelt in Judaea:
- 30. Which also they did, and sent it to the elders by the hands of Barnabas and Saul.

I CORINTHIANS 16:15

15. I beseech you, brethren, (ye know the house of Stephanas, that it is the firstfruits of Achaia, and that they have [addicted] themselves to the [ministry] of the saints,)

II CORINTHIANS 9:6-13

- 6. But this I say, He which soweth sparingly shall reap also sparingly; and he which soweth bountifully shall reap also bountifully. 7. Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver.
- 8. And God is able to make all grace abound toward you; that ye, always having all sufficiency in all things, may abound to every good work: 9. (As it is written, He hath dispersed abroad; he hath given to the poor: his righteousness remaineth for ever.

- 10. Now he that ministereth seed to the sower both minister bread for your food, and multiply your seed sown, and increase the fruits of your righteousness;). 11. Being enriched in every thing to all bountifulness, which causeth through us thanksgiving to God.
- 12. For the [administration] of this service not only supplieth the want of the saints, but is abundant also by many thanksgivings unto God; 13. Whiles by the experiment of this [ministration] they glorify God for your professed subjection unto the gospel of Christ, and for your liberal distribution unto them, and unto all men;

II CORINTHIANS 11:7-8

- 7. Have I committed an offence in abasing myself that ye might be exalted, because I have preached to you the gospel of God freely?
- 8. I robbed other churches, taking wages of them, to do you service.

COLOSSIANS 4:16-17

16. And when this epistle is read among you, cause that it be read also in the church of the Laodiceans; and that ye likewise read the epistle from Laodicea. 17. And say to Archippus, *Take heed to the [ministry] which thou hast received in the Lord, that thou fulfil it.*
