The Attributes Of God Pt5

Kinsman Redeemer

LEVITICUS 25:23-28

23. The land shall not be sold for ever: for the land is mine; for ye are strangers and sojourners with me.

24. And in all the land of your possession ye shall grant a redemption for the land.

25. If thy brother be waxen poor, and hath sold away some of his possession, and if any of his kin come to redeem it, then shall he redeem that which his brother sold.

26. And if the man have none to redeem it, and himself be able to redeem it;

27. Then let him count the years of the sale thereof, and restore the overplus unto the man to whom he sold it; that he may return unto his possession.

28. But if he be not able to restore it to him, then that which is sold shall remain in the hand of him that hath bought it until the year of jubile: and in the jubile it shall go out, and he shall return unto his possession.

LEVITICUS 25:47-49

47. And if a sojourner or stranger wax rich by thee, and thy brother that dwelleth by him wax poor, and sell himself unto the stranger or sojourner by thee, or to the stock of the stranger's family:

48. After that he is sold he may be redeemed again; one of his brethren may redeem him:

49. Either his uncle, or his uncle's son, may redeem him, or any that is nigh of kin unto him of his family may redeem him; or if he be able, he may redeem himself.

GENESIS 3:15

15. And I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed; it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel.

JOHN 4:24

24. God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth.

THE DEITY OF JESUS CHRIST [49-1225]

Now, that's what He came for, to be a Redeemer. And before God could be a Redeemer, He had to be, according to the law, a kinsman Redeemer. He had to be kinfolks to us.

HEBREWS 2:16-17

16. For verily he took not on him the nature of angels; but he took on him the seed of Abraham.17. Wherefore in all things it behoved him to be made like unto his brethren, that he might be a merciful and faithful high priest in things pertaining to God, to make reconciliation for the sins of the people.

REVELATION CHAPTER FIVE PT2 [61-0618]

...God (the Supernatural) became natural to become a Kinsman, because <u>He could not</u> <u>defy His Own laws</u>.

REVELATION 5:1-5

1. And I saw in the right hand of him that sat on the throne a book written within and on the backside, sealed with seven seals.

2. And I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice, Who is worthy to open the book, and to loose the seals thereof?

3. And no man in heaven, nor in earth, neither under the earth, was able to open the book, neither to look thereon.

4. And I wept much, because no man was found worthy to open and to read the book, neither to look thereon.

5. And one of the elders saith unto me, Weep not: behold, the Lion of the tribe of Juda, the Root of David, hath prevailed to open the book, and to loose the seven seals thereof.

POSSESSING THE GATE OF THE ENEMY AFTER TRIAL [64-0322]

Kinsman Redeemer! <u>That's the reason God Himself had to become one of us, to</u> <u>redeem. Nothing else could do it</u>. An Angel couldn't do it, nothing else. He had to come down, be tempted like we are, to redeem us.

<u>RUTH 4:9</u>

9. And Boaz said unto the elders, and unto all the people, Ye are witnesses this day, that I have bought <u>all</u> that was Elimelech's, and <u>all</u> that was Chilion's and Mahlon's, of the hand of Naomi.

THE WATERS OF SEPARATION [55-0606]

And when Christ came to become Man here on earth, and be a Kinsman Redeemer, He redeemed man to everything he lost in the fall; Christ restored it to him in the Kinsman Redeemership. When He died at Calvary, your health, your Eternal Life, **everything that you lost in the fall**, Christ redeems you to it, for He's your Kinsmen Redeemer. Your health, your strength, and everything that you lost, belongs back to you tonight through the Lord Jesus. He became kinfolks to take away sin and sickness.

REDEEMER REDEMPTION [55-1119]

What did He redeem? He redeemed your soul from hell. He redeemed and brought back everything that Adam lost, when he put you in the pawn shop. Jesus Christ, on Calvary was your Kinsman Redeemer that redeemed you from every curse of the devil. He redeems your soul. He redeems your sick body. <u>He redeems your weary, dreary</u> <u>spirit</u>. He brought you happiness. He brought you joy. He brought you... That's what the redemption brought you, brought you peace, long-suffering, goodness, gentleness, meekness, power, the Holy Spirit, brought you Divine healing. All these things Jesus Christ brought to you, because He was our Kinsman Redeemer.

THE MANIFESTATION OF THE SPIRIT [51-0717]

...God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, and become kinfolks to human beings <u>to suffer the penalty that He had put on the human Himself</u>. And He became Kinfolks and a Redeemer. In other words, like this. We was put in the devil's pawn shop, and Jesus paid the price and brought us out.

I CORINTHIANS 6:9-11

9. Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind, 10. Nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom of God. 11. <u>And such were some of you</u>: but ye are washed, but ye are sanctified, but ye are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God.

I CORINTHIANS 6:20

20. For *ye are bought with a price*: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.

EPHESIANS 2:1-9

1. And you hath he quickened, who were dead in trespasses and sins;

2. Wherein in time past ye walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now worketh in the children of disobedience:

3. Among whom also we all had our conversation in times past in the lusts of our flesh,

fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind; and were by nature the children of wrath, even as others.

4. But God, who is rich in mercy, for his great love wherewith he loved us,

5. Even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved;).

6. And hath raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus:

7. That in the ages to come he might shew the exceeding riches of his grace in his kindness toward us through Christ Jesus.

8. For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God:

9. Not of works, lest any man should boast.

II CORINTHIANS 5:19-21

19. To wit, that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation.

20. Now then we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God did beseech you by us: we pray you in Christ's stead, **be ye reconciled to God**.

21. For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; <u>that we might be made the</u> <u>righteousness of God in him</u>.

CHURCH AGE BOOK

The Bible says in II Corinthians 5:21 that we have become the righteousness of God by our union with Jesus Christ. Did you get it? It says that WE ARE THE VERY RIGHTEOUSNESS OF GOD HIMSELF by being IN CHRIST. It says that He (Jesus) became SIN for us. It does not say He became sinful, but became SIN for us that by our union with Him we might become the RIGHTEOUSNESS of God. If we accept the fact (and we must) that He literally became SIN for us by His substitution for us, then we must also accept the fact that we **by our union with Him have become the VERY RIGHTEOUSNESS of God**.

CHURCH AGE BOOK
