ISAIAH 17:7

7. At that day shall a man look to his Maker, and his eyes shall have respect to the Holy One of Israel.

ISAIAH 45:22

22. Look unto me, and be ye saved, all the ends of the earth: for I am God, and there is none else.

PSALM 121:1-2

- 1. I will lift up mine eyes unto the hills, from whence cometh my help.*
- 2. My help cometh from the LORD, which made heaven and earth.*

NUMBERS 21:4-9

- 4. And they journeyed from mount Hor by the way of the Red sea, to compass the land of Edom: and the soul of the people was much discouraged because of the way.*
- 5. And the people spake against God, and against Moses, Wherefore have ye brought us up out of Egypt to die in the wilderness? for there is no bread, neither is there any water; and our soul loatheth this light bread.*
- 6. And the LORD sent fiery serpents among the people, and they bit the people; and much people of Israel died.*
- 7. Therefore the people came to Moses, and said, We have sinned, for we have spoken against the LORD, and against thee; pray unto the LORD, that he take away the serpents from us. And Moses prayed for the people.*
- 8. And the LORD said unto Moses, Make thee a fiery serpent, and set it upon a pole: and it shall come to pass, that every one that is bitten, when he looketh upon it, shall live.*
- 9. And Moses made a serpent of brass, and put it upon a pole, and it came to pass, that if a serpent had bitten any man, when he beheld the serpent of brass, he lived.*

JOHN 3:14-16

- 14. And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of man be lifted up:*
- 15. That whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have eternal life.*
- 16. For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.*

JOHN 12:32-33

- 32. And I, if I be lifted up from the earth, will draw all men unto me.*
- 33. This he said, signifying what death he should die.*

WITNESSES [54-0303]

It was in the Old Testament, they had the brass serpent; they looked and lived. And that's what we do tonight, is look and live, look to Jesus and live.

THE SEAL OF GOD [54-0514]

Don't look back there to Wesley, Methodists, and all those, Baptists, and Presbyterians. Look here to Jesus Christ, the Author and Finisher of the faith of the Bible.

MATTHEW 14:25-31

25. *And in the fourth watch of the night Jesus went unto them, walking on the sea.*
26. *And when the disciples saw him walking on the sea, they were troubled, saying, It is a spirit; and they cried out for fear.*
27. *But straightway Jesus spake unto them, saying, Be of good cheer; it is I; be not afraid.*
28. *And Peter answered him and said, Lord, if it be thou, bid me come unto thee on the water.*
29. *And he said, Come. And when Peter was come down out of the ship, he walked on the water, to go to Jesus.*
30. ***But when he saw the wind boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink, he cried, saying, Lord, save me.***
31. *And immediately Jesus stretched forth his hand, and caught him, and said unto him, O thou of little faith, wherefore didst thou doubt?*

LOOK [63-0428]

...see Him and see Him only, not some bishop, some great man, or something we take pattern by, but we look to Jesus Christ. Not some organization, not some pope, or--or some archbishop of Canterbury, or some other "Divine man," that we call on earth. But we must look to Jesus Christ. He is the Word.

LOOK AWAY TO JESUS [63-1229E]

Now remember, now, I am just your brother. I sure you understand that. I am a man; He is God. But God only can work, and always has worked, and only worked, through man. Now look tonight, not to me or to any other person, but look to Jesus Christ.

MARK 9:1-8

1. *And he said unto them, Verily I say unto you, That there be some of them that stand here, which shall not taste of death, till they have seen the kingdom of God come with power.*
2. *And after six days Jesus taketh with him Peter, and James, and John, and leadeth them up into an high mountain apart by themselves: and he was transfigured before them.*

3. *And his raiment became shining, exceeding white as snow; so as no fuller on earth can white them.* 4. *And there appeared unto them Elias with Moses: and they were talking with Jesus.* 5. *And Peter answered and said to Jesus, Master, it is good for us to be here: and let us make three tabernacles; one for thee, and one for Moses, and one for Elias.* 6. *For he wist not what to say; for they were sore afraid.* 7. *And there was a cloud that overshadowed them: and a voice came out of the cloud, saying, This is my beloved Son: hear him.* 8. *And suddenly, when they had looked round about, they saw no man any more, save Jesus only with themselves.*

HEBREWS 12:1-2a

1. *Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us,* 2a. **Looking unto Jesus** *the author and finisher of our faith;*

HEBREWS 2:7-9a

7. *Thou madest him a little lower than the angels; thou crownedst him with glory and honour, and didst set him over the works of thy hands:* 8. *Thou hast put all things in subjection under his feet. For in that he put all in subjection under him, he left nothing that is not put under him. But now we see not yet all things put under him.* 9a. **But we see Jesus,**

JOHN 12:20-21

20. *And there were certain Greeks among them that came up to worship at the feast:* 21. *The same came therefore to Philip, which was of Bethsaida of Galilee, and desired him, saying, **Sir, we would see Jesus.***

LOOKING AT THE UNSEEN [59-0410]

Don't look at your disease; you can never get well. Don't look to your affliction. Look to Jesus; He's the one.

Look to Jesus; He's the One to look to.

LOOKING UNTO JESUS [64-0122]

Now, some people, when they look to Jesus, they look and see Him, look and look at Him, and when they see Him, they see in Him only a church founder, or a--a--a church organizer, or maybe a--a creed for a church. That's what many people look to Jesus to see. He is just a new creed that was added to an old doctrine. Now many people look and see Him like that.

Some look and see Him as a myth, Santa Claus. Or, some of them look to Him as some historical act that God did many years ago. Some of them look to Him yet as a baby in a manger.

But, the question is, **what do you see when you look at Him?** Do you see the second person of the trinity, or do you see a trinity, three in One? You'll only see Him as you look at Him through the Word. That's the only way you know It, because He is the Word. It'll reveal Himself. Depends on what you're looking for.

SPIRITUAL ADOPTION [56-0923]

Don't look to the law, because the law cannot be kept. But look to Jesus only, for He is the One Who redeemed you, and through faith in His Name, you could be made well this morning.

LOOKING UNTO JESUS [64-0122]

The dying thief looked to Him, in the hour of distress, and what did he find? He found His pardon. **Who else could he look to?** The Roman government wouldn't pardon him. No one else would pardon him. But he looked to Jesus, in his distress, and he found Somebody Who could pardon him.

My brother, sister, tonight, if you are hanging like he was then, on the balance of condemnation; and knowing, if you'd die, tonight, as a lukewarm church member, or a lukewarm Pentecostal, or whatever you might be, you know where you are going. Look to Him, tonight, the One Who can set you free. One, tonight, if you're just only a membership only, and don't know what the resurrection of Christ means to live in a human heart, look to Him. He is God, and He alone. You'll find pardoning like this poor, thick, sin-sick thief did, hanging on the Cross.

THE PRINCIPLES OF DIVINE HEALING [51-0923]

No matter how sinful you are, no matter how stooped you've been in sin, if you'll look to Jesus Christ and believe Him as your Saviour and confess Him to be, God will save you by His grace.

GOD MANIFESTING HIS GIFTS [57-0805]
