I JOHN 1:7-10

7. *But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin.*
8. *If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.*
9. *If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.*
10. *If we say that we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us.*

3. *Who had his dwelling among the tombs; and no man could bind him, no, not with chains:*
4. *Because that he had been often bound with fetters and chains, and the chains had been plucked asunder by him, and the fetters broken in pieces: neither could any man tame him.*
5. *And always, night and day, he was in the mountains, and in the tombs, crying, and cutting himself with stones.*

MARK 5:9

9. *And he asked him, What is thy name? And he answered, saying, My name is Legion: for we are many.*

ACTS 1:13-14

13. *And when they were come in, they went up into an upper room, where abode both Peter, and James, and John, and Andrew, Philip, and Thomas, Bartholomew, and Matthew, James the son of Alphaeus, and Simon Zelotes, and Judas the brother of James.*

14. *These all continued with one accord in prayer and supplication, with the women, and **Mary the mother of Jesus**, and with his brethren.*

ACTS 2:1-4

1. *And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place.*
2. *And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting.*
3. *And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them.*

Consider this. Since it is the blood of God, it is perfect blood; and if the perfect blood is loosing us from the power and bondage and defilement of sin, then the loosing is perfect and complete. There is now therefore no condemnation.

"Who shall lay anything to the charge of God's elect? It is God that justifieth (declares us righteous). Who is he that condemneth? It is Christ that died..." Romans 8:33-34.
