THE INSIDE MAN [53-1212]

All those gifts according to the Scripture was set in <u>for the perfecting of the Church</u>. Is that right? Now, God put them in there.

WHY I'M PRAYING FOR THE SICK [54-0314]

...God set in the church, first apostles, and teachers, and prophets, and all kinds of gifts for the perfecting of the body. You believe that, don't you?

Now, that's what I believe, that God has set these in the church...

DIVINE HEALING [54-0620E]

And the only way that He has to represent Himself here on earth is with you and I. And God has set some in the church to be teachers, some to be a--for different gifts, some prophets, some different things. I never did say where they'd be set out of the church. He set them in the church for the perfecting of the church and to be in the church until He comes again.
