#### **GENESIS 13:14-17**

- 14. And the LORD said unto Abram, after that Lot was separated from him, Lift up now thine eyes, and look from the place where thou art northward, and southward, and eastward, and westward:
- 15. For all the land which thou seest, to thee will I give it, and to thy seed for ever.
- 16. And I will make thy seed as the dust of the earth: so that if a man can number the dust of the earth, then shall thy seed also be numbered. 17. Arise, walk through the land in the length of it and in the breadth of it; for I will give it unto thee.

### ACTS 6:8-10

- 8. And Stephen, full of faith and power, did great wonders and miracles among the people.
- 9. Then there arose certain of the synagogue, which is called the synagogue of the Libertines, and Cyrenians, and Alexandrians, and of them of Cilicia and of Asia, disputing with Stephen.
- 10. And they were not able to resist the <u>wisdom</u> and the <u>spirit</u> by which he spake.

#### **ACTS 7:2-5**

- 2. And he said, Men, brethren, and fathers, hearken; The God of glory appeared unto our father Abraham, when he was in Mesopotamia, before he dwelt in Charran,
- 3. And said unto him, Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and come into the land which I shall shew thee.
- 4. Then came he out of the land of the Chaldaeans, and dwelt in Charran: and from thence, when his father was dead, he removed him into this land, wherein ye now dwell.

5. And he gave him none inheritance in it, no, <u>not so much as to set his foot on</u>: yet he promised that he would give it to him for a possession, and to his seed after him, when as yet he had no child.
